



FACULTY DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP ON GLOBAL HEALTH

OTS hosted at the Las Cruces Research Station an incredible one-week faculty development workshop with educators from six countries and twenty-four universities. Carlos A. Faerron Guzmán, OTS' Academic Director, co-designed and co-facilitated this workshop along with leading experts Caryl Waggett from Allegheny University, Brittany Seymour from Harvard University, Dawn Whitehead from the American Association of Colleges and Universities, Barb Astle from Trinity Western University, Jessica Evert from Child Family Health International, and Peter J. Brown from Emory University.

The workshop addressed fundamental topics including assessment rubrics, risk management, pre-course preparation, and ethics in global health education and practice. Moreover, OTS facilitated the course's experiential components, which included visits to La Casona Indigenous Territory, Rio Sereno Border Post and Casas de la Alegria (Joy Houses).
